Albuquerque Christian School (ACS) is an independent PreK-8th grade Christian school in northeast Albuquerque, New Mexico. ACS is an interdenominational school that is fully committed to the education of the children at our school. We want to partner with parents to contribute to the growth of our children both spiritually and academically. We will teach Biblical truth to every student, and each student will attend group assemblies, which will include the Pledge of Allegiance, singing a patriotic song, and singing praise songs. The Bible is used as a resource for life. All faculty and staff members are fully committed to healthy development of each child. We will promote Christian values based on the Bible in all academic and extracurricular activities. We will not promote the specific doctrine of a particular denomination of Christianity and will refer students' questions concerning highly debatable topics to their parents. Our goal is to let the Lord work through us to create a wholesome, Spirit-filled, loving, and safe Christian environment where children can grow spiritually and academically in Christ's love. ACS has been accredited through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) since 1982.

Our History

Steve and Cindy West founded Albuquerque Christian School in 1981. The school opened its doors to students in the fall of 1982, at the Avalon Road Church of Christ. A number of Church of Christ congregations have graciously shared their facilities with ACS over the years, including both Mountainside and Netherwood Church of Christ. Today, many of our families come to ACS without a church home, and the school serves a dual purpose for them in hopes that they will find a church to call home. Today ACS occupies its own building in northeast Albuquerque that includes a staff of 16 teachers, three educational aides, business manager, an admissions/ marketing/development coordinator, and an administrative assistant. The two year old building space contains 16 classrooms, a full sized gym, offices, staff workroom, staff lounge, meeting room, commercial kitchen, and two outdoor playground spaces.

The 2020 school year enrollment reached 112 and current enrollment for the 2021-22 school year is currently at 120 and growing. ACS is spiritually strong, and both students and parents cherish its loving, Christ-centered environment. Bible is not just another subject, but is integrated into every aspect, both academic and extra-curricular, at ACS. Students thrive both at ACS and later in chosen high schools and beyond. The faculty and parents are devoted to the mission and actively contribute their time and energy to the school.

The Board of Directors is currently seeking candidates to consider as they continue to build a growing school community.

The incoming Head of School/Principal will be a dynamic leader, strong communicator, and a committed follower of Jesus Christ; modeling a vibrant, authentic, and personal faith.
